Pablo AtchugarryTime's Folds

Spanning three decades of Pablo Atchugarry's career, Time's Fold's is the artist's first exhibition at Piero Atchugarry, Miami. The survey includes some twenty hypnotic sculptures. All Atchugarry's prime materials are here. From pristine white Carrara and warm Portuguese pink marbles to bronze and wood. The expansive display also serves, in a sense, as a concise retrospective - a window onto Atchugarry's core themes. While his dexterity is rooted in matter, the imaginative scope at stake reaches much further. The translucent, crystalline marble at once captures luminosity and radiates it back from within. Likewise, cherry wood sculptures introduce an organic note, suggesting growth rising from below. Throughout, vertical contours and curves multiply toward infinity - not least when rendered in bronze coated with strong, glossy colors that intensify reflections, linear shadows and vivid highlights. The sculptural fold itself is a gesture rooted in duration, chiefly abstract though laden with figurative hints. Above all, these factors address a fundamental goal. Universality. near Italy's Lake Como. Nevertheless, his ultimate aim is universal: "I think that every one of us was born with a vision, and our goal is to share it with mankind." The works incarnate this generosity. Their elements remain timeless - light, stone and movement keyed to a constant verticality, as if earthbound existence forever seeks higher realms. The exhibition's sightlines, changing motifs, calibrated scale and formal harmonies unfold in time. Undulating through space, Atchugarry's sentinel presences prompt emotions and thoughts unique to each viewer's heart and mind. - David Anfam, Curator

David Anfam is the Managing Director of Art Exploration Consultancy Ltd, London, and Senior Consulting Curator Emeritus at the Clyfford Still Museum, Denver. Dr. Anfam is an international curator, writer and critic. He has also been the Luce Visiting Professor in American Art at Brandeis University and for almost twenty years was Commissioning Editor for Fine Art at Phaidon Press. Dr. Anfam's diverse books include Abstract Expressionism (Thames & Hudson, 1990; second edition 2015); Mark Rothko: The Works on Canvas - Catalogue Raisonné (Yale University Press, 1998; sixth printing 2019) and Anish Kapoor (Phaidon Press, 2009). Since 1990, Anfam has contributed essays to more than seventy exhibition catalogues, ranging in subject from Jackson Pollock, Edward Kienholz, Franz Kline, Lee Krasner, Robert Rauschenberg and David Smith to Max Beckmann, Pier Paolo Calzolari, Piero Dorazio, Wayne Thiebaud and Zeng Fanzhi. Among Anfam's various exhibitions, Abstract Expressionism (Royal Academy of Arts, London, 2016–17) was the largest survey of its kind ever held in Europe. Most recently, Anfam curated Lynda Benglis: In the Realm of the Senses at the Museum of Cycladic Art (NEON, Athens, 2019-20).

On occasion the Gallery's represented artists are invited to showcase an exploratory body of work outside of their usual oeuvre.

Pablo Atchugarry, (B.1954, Uruguay) is internationally renowned for his monumental public sculptures. After experimenting with a variety of materials early in his career, Atchugarry turned to marble as his primary medium. Simultaneously abstract and numinous, massive and delicately carved, his sculptures are reflections on the intervention of the spiritual in everyday life, intended to channel spiritual energies into the spaces they occupy and invite contemplation of the divine. Atchugarry is influenced by the seminal work of Constantin Brancusi and Henry Moore, and often likened to Michelangelo in his similar devotion to working with his own hands (as opposed to the workshop practices of several of his contemporaries).
